Do NOT

- Use your talent in public if it is visible in any way.
- Use your talent in public unless you have to.

Do NOT

• Trust another Para & especially not a Normal with your identity without making sure they are in the Underground. If they don't say the 2nd half of the Underground Code back to you, do not engage.

Do NOT

- Engage with ParaTroopers unless you absolutely have to. If you have to, be submissive.
- Challenge ParaTroopers. Get away as soon as you can without raising suspicion.

If you get taken by ParaTroopers, do not fight back. Many a Trooper has shocked a Para to death with only a fine and a slap on the wrist.

Protect yourself and the ones you love. Try not to get caught. Rely on the

Do

- Gain the acceptance of the Normals around you. Maintain the status quo.
- Be polite. It helps people trust you.


Do

 Blend in with Normals as fast & as well as you can. Never forget they're watching.

Do

 Know the anti-Para slogans off by heart.
Be able to recite them when prompted as if you believe in them. Laugh at or agree with the anti-Para remarks you hear. It will help keep you safe.
Make sure you are always in contact with the Underground, in case you need to relocate quickly.
Have an escape bag packed, in case you need to run.

Travel light. If you have to run, have your belongings packed in 1 bag, 2 at the most, that you can carry yourself.
Have a reason prepared for your travel, and a destination in mind.
Learn your new identity inside out. Make sure you respond to your new name, whether it's a new first name, last name, or both.



Keep Safe. Keep Strong! Never give up hope.

Remember there are Underground contacts in most states and provinces. You are not alone!
